$$\frac{\text{Hours Spent Producing Result Before IT} - \text{Hours Spent Producing Result After IT}}{\text{Hours Spent Producing Result Before IT}}$$

The gains realized from productivity may be grouped into two categories: labor and production.

Labor hours consumed producing a desired result can be determined before and after the implementation of the IT system. The labor productivity gain is easily measured by a simple percentage.
